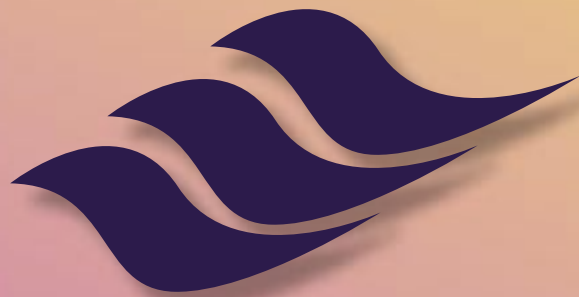

Newark Sixth sees the team from Lincoln College's highly successful A Level Centre, one of the largest sixth forms in the region, offering courses in Newark as part of a range of exciting post-16 options.

Same tutors, same support, same success

Last year our students achieved a 98% pass rate at A Level and superb vocational course results. We successfully supported our fourth Cambridge University entrant in two years and our students progressed to a host of universities such as St. Andrews, Nottingham, Lancaster, Sheffield, York, Hull, Keele, Kent, Aberdeen, Leicester, and to Royal Holloway and Imperial College in London.

All Level 3 courses in Newark Sixth attract 'UCAS' points, which are needed for entry to university and we aim that all learners achieve this or are well placed to enter employment if they prefer.

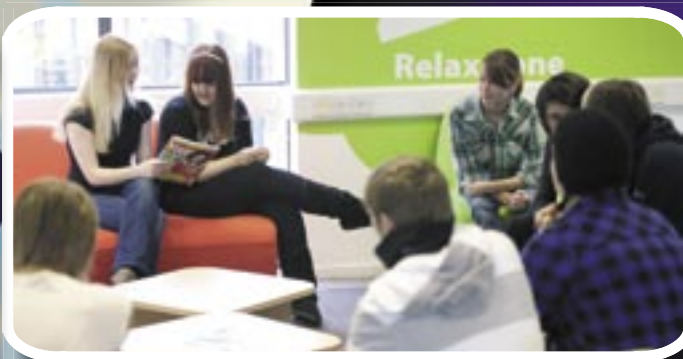
Lucy, who gained an A and 3 Bs at A Level, now studying BA(Hons) Psychology.

Alternative routes to A Levels

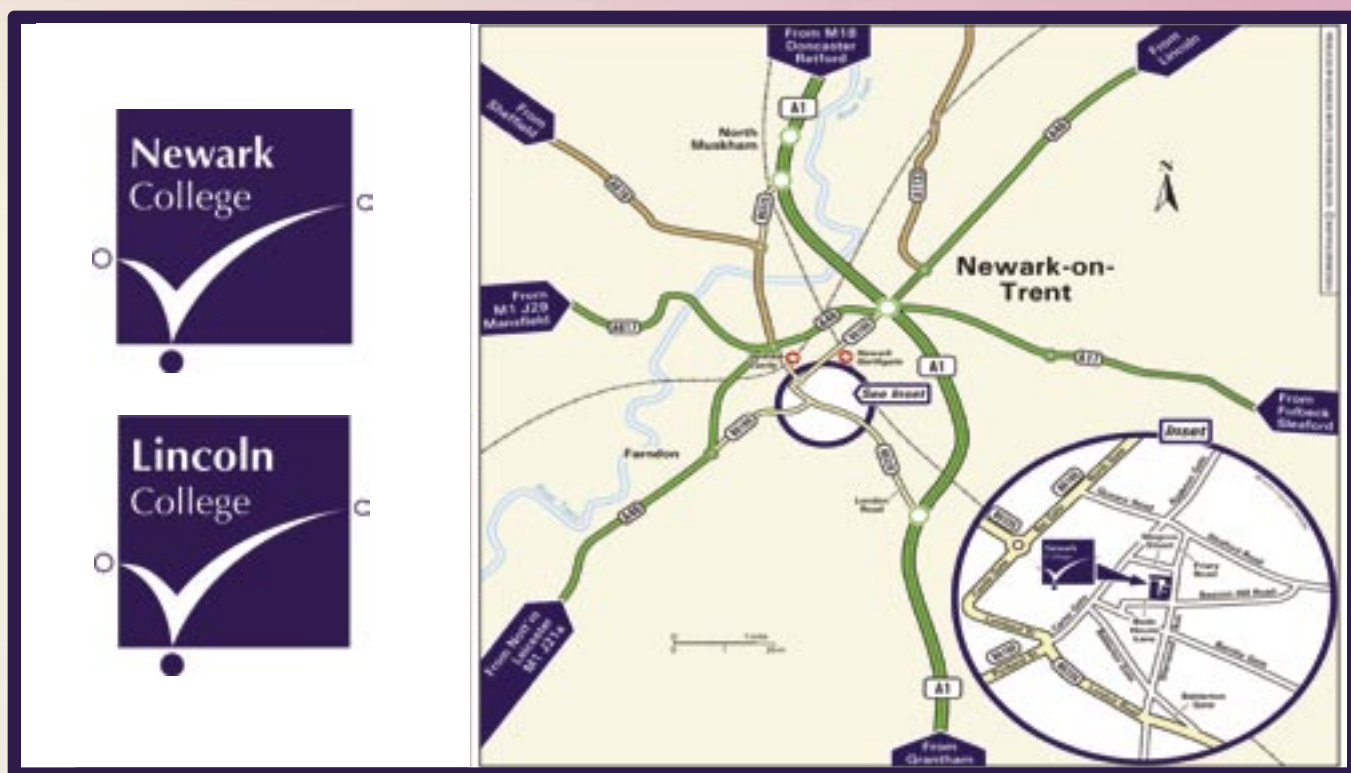
The entry requirements for our two-year A Level programme are quite firm, as we need to know you're ready to be successful at this level. If you don't think you'll get there straight away, all is not lost.

Pre-A Programme

The Pre A is an intensive and demanding one-year course for students who want to join our A Level programme but fall just short of the entry requirements, including the need to attain a C in GCSE English Language. It can also be suitable for students who had their study seriously disrupted by illness or other factors. The subjects include GCSEs in English, Maths, Science, Sociology, Psychology and BTEC Law.

Bridging Course (three-year A Level Programme)

The course is designed for students who haven't studied the right mix of GCSEs or BTECs at school to get onto the A Levels of their choice. Our one-year Bridging Course comprises a single AS Level, a Level 2 qualification enabling you to develop good study, research & time management skills and the opportunity to take GCSE Maths & Science if you do not already have these at GCSE grade C. Students join the two-year A Level programme the following autumn.
