

Living in Lincoln

Lincoln offers a great mix of wonderful gothic architecture, quaint cobbled streets and modern city living. The 'Uphill' historic quarter is home to the world famous Lincoln Cathedral and Lincoln Castle, which holds an original 1215 Magna Carta, which people travel from all over the world to see. Cushioned with boutique shops, restaurants and traditional pubs – it's a global tourist destination.

The South of the city is packed with high street shops, great places to eat and buzzing bars, clubs, restaurants and coffee shops. Lincoln is a green city with a relaxed ambiance. It has low crime rates and a diverse and accepting local community.

There are plenty of live-music venues and open mic sessions, a growing LGBT scene and a strong alternative culture following. Lincoln is now the home of the international Steampunk movement and once a year the city is awash with a celebration of Sci-fi Victoriana as the Punks meet for their annual convention.

The City has excellent transport links and is just an hour from Nottingham and the East Coast.

Although we do not have our own accommodation at the College, there is a plentiful supply located in the city, within walking distance of the College and both rail and bus stations.
