Once you earn over this amount, you pay back 9% of the earnings you receive above this figure.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the loan, you must be 19 or older on the first day of your course (there's no upper age limit), be living in the UK on the first day of your course, and have lived in the UK, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man for 3 years immediately before this.
